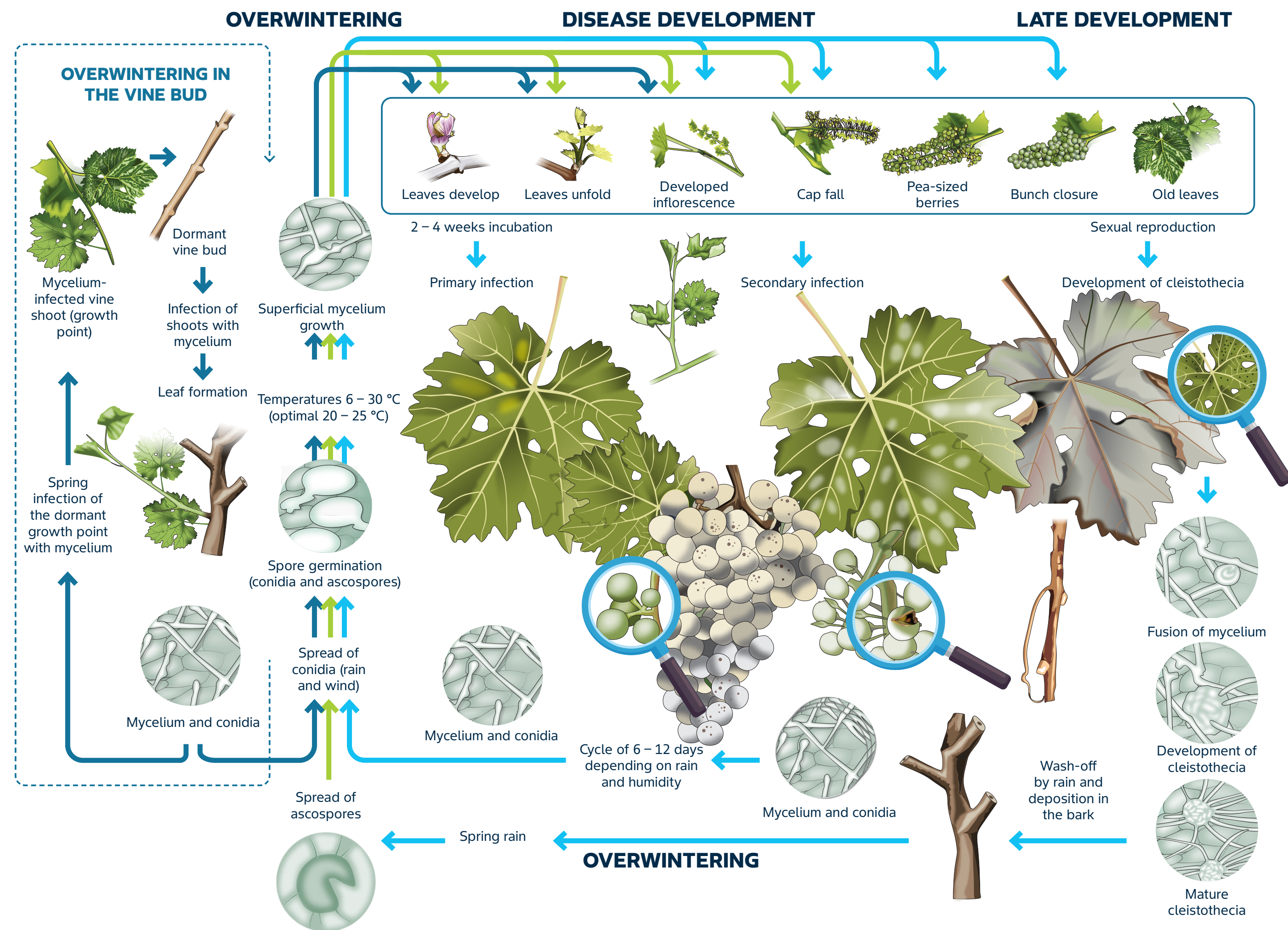

Disease cycle of Powdery Mildew



Powdery Mildew (*Erysiphe necator*)

Powdery mildew is a common fungal disease that affects grapevines, causing significant yield and economic losses, and negatively affecting wine quality (reduced yields and poor fruit quality) if left uncontrolled. The disease is caused by the fungus *Erysiphe necator* (formerly *Uncinula necator*). It appears as a white, powdery coating on various parts of the vine, including leaves, shoots, flowers, and grapes.

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
